For each additional person, add \$5,400 to annual income.

REQUIREMENTS FOR SERVICE

- Proof of Income - all household members for the last 30 days.
- Social Security cards for all household members.
- Most recent home heating bill.

- Proof of age for household members 65 years old or older.
- Must be a resident of Atlanta-Fulton County
- US Citizenship or legally admitted alien.


